SAFETY & IMPORTANT CAMP POLICIES

Safety

At Camp Gan Israel our primary concern is your child's safety. There will always be a staff member present that is trained in First Aid. We strive to maintain counselor/camper ratios that far exceed those mandated by the State. Certified lifeguards (in addition to counselors) supervise swimming, and when on field trips the on-site director will always be present.

In case of a medical emergency, G-d forbid, parents (or guardian) and family doctor (listed on the registration papers) will be contacted immediately.

The South Peninsula Hebrew Day School location is equipped with a perimeter security fence. The entrances to the camp will be locked during the camp day. They will only be open during pick-up and drop-off.

We strongly encourage you to apply sunscreen on your child before attending camp and to send your child with their own bottle of sunscreen every day to camp. The staff will reapply it throughout the day unless you instruct us otherwise. Please send a cap or hat with your child for additional sun protection.

Important Policies

Nut Products: This summer absolutely NO NUT OR NUT PRODUCTS will not be allowed in camp.

Parents must sign their child/ren in each morning with the on-site director.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND MEDICATION

If your child has any special challenges or conditions (i.e. social, behavioral), the knowledge of which would help us in caring for them and maximizing their camp experience, please bring them to our attention. It will allow us to address these needs properly and eliminate unnecessary difficulties.

All medication to be administered during camp hours must be clearly marked with the camper's name and be provided in its original container. A separate note containing dosage instruction and parent's signature must be sent as well. If you would like to discuss your child's health situation, please call Rabbi Sherf at the camp office.

FUNSHOPS

Art: We have developed a specialized art program for the campers that will expose them to various techniques, allowing the children to explore their creativity using a variety of media.

Fun with Food: Campers will roll up their sleeves, don aprons and have fun exploring their creativity with food!

Mad Science: Mad Science of the Bay Area will lead weekly and entertaining workshops, including:

Dry Ice Capades, Slime Time and Fantastic Fliers!

Jewish Holiday Workshops: Campers will craft their own shofar, create a beeswax Havdallah candle, learn how to write Hebrew letters using a feather and ink and bake their own matzah. They will learn the meaning behind these mitzvot with a fun and educational workshop!

TRIPS

Trips days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Our trip schedule is especially tailored for the ages of our Gan Izzy campers. The locations chosen are in secure environments with a pace and content suited for this age group. Please keep in mind that all the trips are subject to change; however, you will be notified of any changes in advance if at all possible.

Campers **must wear the Gan Izzy Camp T-shirt** on the trip days. They will receive a Camp T-Shirt on their first day of Camp. If you need to purchase additional shirts, they are available for \$10—please contact the on-site director.

Should your child attend without a camp T-shirt, you will be charged for an additional T-shirt that will be given them.

All campers will wear wristbands with the camp director's phone number as an additional safety measure.

SWIMMING

The campers will swim on Mondays and Wednesdays at the Columbia Middle School Pool that we have rented exclusively for our use. Certified lifeguards hired through the City of Sunnyvale Aquatics program will be present.

Please be sure to send along a bathing suit, towel, goggles (optional) as well as sunscreen. The counselors will assist your child in re-applying sunscreen after they swim. If your child needs floaties, please be sure to send along.

JEWISH ENRICHMENT

We believe that Judaism is not a history subject, but a vibrant way of life. At Camp Gan Israel, the campers will gain a positive perspective of Judaism, discovering it through song, craft, games and activities. The campers will hear Torah stories, learn about the weekly Torah portion, and discover Jewish values. Each week will have a theme, which will be carried on throughout the week. The staff will integrate the theme in the children's activities making their learning a memorable and positive experience.

TRANSPORTATION

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How does my camper find lost items?

Please mark all belongings with your camper's name and group. This is very important since shirts are identical and individual items are difficult to identify without a label. Lost & Found items are available each day in the office. Please contact us in writing or by phone regarding specific items.

How do I arrange to pick up my camper during the camp day?

If you have to pick up your camper during the day, please notify the site-director. Once we are aware of your arrival time, we can arrange to have your camper ready for you. We cannot release campers without parental permission.

What if my child does not want to participate in a particular activity?

No camper is forced to participate in any activity. However, we do urge campers to try all activities and take advantage of the complete program offered at camp Gan Israel. We appreciate parental input and feedback on this matter.

What does my camper need each day?

Campers should have sunscreen at the camp at all times. A bathing suit and towel should be sent on swim days. We supply all equipment.

How can I speak with my child's counselor?

A call to the camp office will answer most questions. Since counselors are constantly supervising groups and activities, messages will be taken at the camp office. Please leave your name and evening phone number and the counselor will return your call as soon as possible.
